

VSSUT Student Clubs/Societies/Chapters/ Associations

Activities of different technical clubs and cultural clubs are monitored by Dean, Student Welfare. Each club has a separate faculty advisor, student secretary, Assistant Secretary and student members. Technical Clubs and Cultural clubs are finally controlled by separate Vice-presidents and Faculty Advisors of the concerned clubs. A student activity council (SAC) has been constituted to coordinate students so as to give them an opportunity to develop leadership by organizing and carrying out University activities and projects.

The following are the important Clubs, Associations and Societies of the students of the University. Nomination to the various clubs, associations and societies are made generally in the month of August/September every year. Secretaries and Asst. Secretaries of these student bodies are selected from 3rd year and 2nd year students respectively. However, the chief Editor of Galaxy(of final year students) is nominated from amongst the B.Tech final year students.

STUDENT ACTIVITY COUNCIL (SAC) COMPOSITION

Members: Vice-Presidents, Faculty Advisors, Associated N.C.C. Officer (ANO), 3(O) CTC NCC, VSSUT Burla, N.S.S. Coordinator, the student Secretaries and Assistant Secretaries of all the Associations/Clubs,/Societies such as Students Cultural Association, SSG & Students Aid Fund, Dramatic Association, Music and Dance Club, Athletic Club, Art & Photography Club, Literary Society, Audiovisual Club, Robotics Club, Galaxy, Samavesh, Yoga Teacher-in-charge, ISTE Chapters, SAE Students Chapters. Activities of various students' Associations, Clubs and Societies are mentioned below. All the Faculty Advisors in consultation with their Vice-presidents of various Associations/Clubs,/Societies including SSG/NCC/NSS/ISTE/IEEE/ASME make financial audit at the end of each year and submit an annual report of activities by June of every academic year(July to June). The term of office of every Vice-President and Faculty Advisor shall be two years from the date of their appointment, and they shall not be eligible for reappointment for the next consecutive term.

All vacancies arising by any reason or otherwise among the Vice-Presidents and Faculty Advisors of any of the above mentioned Associations/Clubs,/Societies etc. of the University, shall be filled up as soon as convenient by Dean(SW) following University procedure, and any person so nominated shall hold office for the unexpired portion of the term of his predecessor in office. All the files shall be routed through Dean(SW) to keep the track of all activities. All the clubs and Societies will prepare the budget estimate for various activities within the anticipated receipt of the fund. They will also prepare the prospective annual plan of action of their societies for the academic session every year for approval of authority. The Vice-Chancellor (in consultation with Dean-SW) shall be the final authority in all matters relating to any student activities and his decision with respect to the functioning of the clubs and societies shall be final and binding.

The following faculty members shall be the nominee of the Vice Chancellor for different Clubs, Associations and Societies for the Academic Sessions 2019-2021.

STUDENT TECHNICAL SOCIETIES

SAMAVESH: Samavesh is the Annual National level Techno-Management/Festival of the University organized in the month of January/February every year. It has now become the largest technical festival in the state of Odisha and is headed towards becoming the biggest fest of its kind in the country. It serves as a platform for interaction between the industry and academic, and it also brings together thousands of engineering and applied science students from all over the country to exhibit their innovations and Novel designs/Proto types/Products/Robots, and also present technical papers.



ROBOTICS CLUB: Students organize different club activities based on robotics and showcase it during Samavesh. They participate in different National level competitions and establishments .

IDEA CLUB: Idea Innovation Cell is the official innovation club of the institute, established to enthuse students for innovation and research. It provides adequate opportunities for budding technocrats to put forth extraordinary ideas and come up with innovative projects that can solve basic community problems of daily life. The club is equipped with various scientific tools and instruments to intrigue innovative practices. AUDIO VISUAL CLUB: The Audio Visual Club provides entertainment to students and staff members, by way of screening Hindi/English/Oriya films once or twice a week. The club is equipped with one 35mm projector along with all its accessories to screen films. A standby generator is also connected to meet the requirements during power failure. Members are

STUDENTS SPORTS SOCIETIES

ATHLETIC CLUB: It promotes athletic activity among the students and to conduct the sports and athletic tournaments of the University. It also arranges and supervise participation of the University teams in the various student-teacher friendly matches, inter Halls /inter class competitions, inter University, interstate sports and athletic meets. The athletic club is well equipped with a Gymnasium and athletic video library with all modern facilities and infrastructures.
