The discussions adhere to the official procedures and protocols of the United Nations. Each conference consists of several sessions for each committee, and the proposed solutions by the delegates are formulated into detailed resolutions, which are then voted on by the respective committees.

The United Nations Commission on the Status of Women (UNCSW) is a global body advancing women's rights and gender equality, focusing on civil, social, and educational rights.



JPC

The Joint Parliamentary Committee investigates and examines national issues and policies. Delegates represent political parties and collaborate on reports and recommendations.



UNODC

Contributes to global peace and security, sustainable development and human rights by helping to make the world safer from drugs, crime, corruption and terrorism.

The IP is made up of news agencies and broadcasters who are free to report on and debate what happens at MUN.



DISEC

The agendas ranged from socio economic development in India to climate changes. The agreements achieved were then made into draft resolutions to be voted upon by the committee. 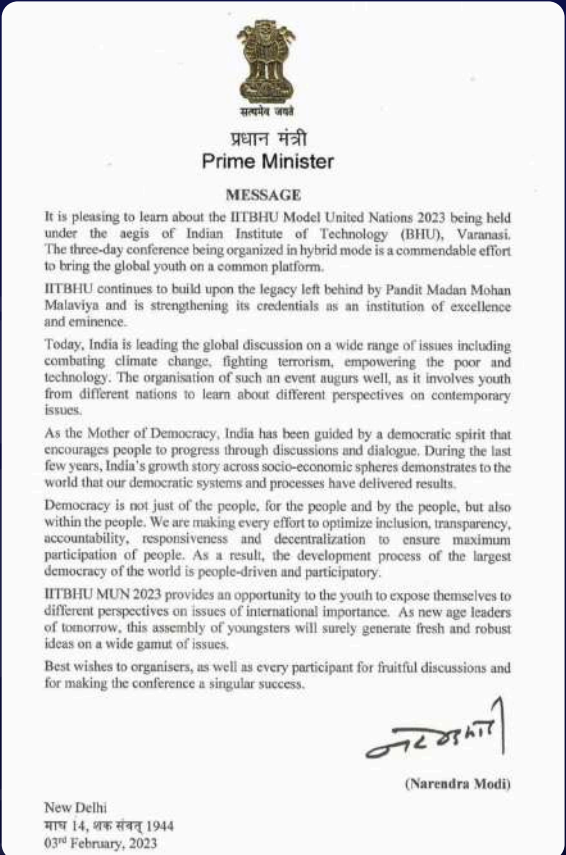
