CULTURAL SOCIETY OF VSSUT



• INK ABLAZE



SHORT STORY WRITING COMPETITION




• POEM WRITING COMPETITION

• LITVAGANZA




• THE BIG PICTURE RENDEZVOUS

creativity, thoughtfulness, and dedication to this








• YOU THE VOICE




comedy, graphic designers and many more. Along with these the induction programme was concluded with selection of a variety of budding young artists.
