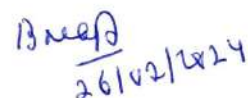

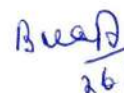

But, the Local Fund Audit has raised an objection which may be reads as follows:</p> <p><i>“Examinership, Invigilation works: Examinership including invigilation will be a part of the academic duty of the college teachers. They will not be entitled to any remuneration for examination work including invigilation work, setting of question papers, correction of answer scripts etc. That may be assigned to them by the college authorities or by the Universities of the State”</i></p> <p>Hence, it is proposed to discontinue payment of remuneration to Faculty for examination-related works from now onwards, however, the payment made so far need not be recovered from faculty.</p> <p>Resolution: <i>The BOM approved the proposal.</i></p>

Restructuring of the School of Computer Sciences and Courses offered.

As per the 33rd Academic Council (**AC-2023-33.08**) deliberations and approval made on the suggestions made by the School of Computer Compute Sciences, the following resolutions are made and recommended for approval by BOM.

- (a) The existing intake of B.Tech. in Information Technology and Computer Science will be merged and the total intake will be offered for Computer Science and Engineering (120 nos). This is because IT and CSE have 90% of courses in common and CSE is more accepted in the Industry and Academia of repute.
- (b) The present qualification norms for MCA students through the OJEE do not restrict the students with poor backgrounds and as a result, it has been observed that poor-quality students are getting admitted. It has also an impact on placement. Further, the MCA course has been modified to two years in contrast to three years as earlier. Considering this, it is suggested to either modify the eligibility criteria for admission or to stop the MCA admission and take the same number of students in Computer Science and Engineering.

However, the necessary decisions be made in consultation and approval from the SD&TE Department.

- (c) M.Tech. Programs earlier offered in the IT Department will be dropped and the following M.Tech. Programmes will be offered in the School of Computer Sciences. This is decided considering the present trends and needs of the industry and academia.

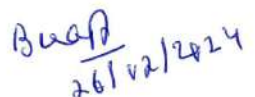

- (d) Considering the IDP implementation, where the main mandate is to increase the B.Tech. intake, The new courses proposed to be offered to be introduced gracefully year by year For the Academic Year 2024-25 the following programmes will be offered after due approval from the SD&TE Department

- (i) B.Tech. CSE: 120
- (ii) B.Tech. CSE (Specialisation AI & ML):60
- (iii) M.Tech. CSE (Specialization: CSE): 36
- (ii) M.Tech. CSE (Specialization: AI&ML): 18
- (iv) M.Tech. CSE (Specialization: Data Sciences): 18
- (v) M.Tech. CSE (Specialization: IOT): 18
- (vi) M.Tech. CSE (Specialization: Cyber Security): 18

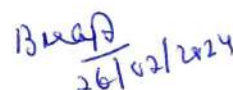
- (e) The School of Computer Sciences will have no department and the School will offer the programmes in B.Tech., M.Tech., MCA, and Ph.D. (CSE). The appointments and the services of all the faculty and technical staff members of the present CSE, IT, and MCA Departments are being transferred to the School of Computer Sciences w.e.f. 13/02/2024, the date of the 46th meeting of BOM. Considering their professional growth of faculty, all qualifications and specializations will be taken into account for Direct and CAS recruitment if they fulfil other eligibility criteria as per AICTE norms.

This will have an adverse impact on the recruitment of Faculty.
