 Evaluation for 1st semester of B.Tech, B.Arch and 5 years Integrated B.Tech & M.Tech Dual Degree and upcoming Even Semester of 2021-22 for all other courses and year.

(A) Theory subjects evaluation

Mid Semester Examination - (30 Marks: 90 Minutes)

End Semester Examination - (50 Marks: 150 Minutes)

Teacher's Assessment (TA) -20 Marks:

(Student involvement in classes: Attendance, interaction and general attitude: 5 Marks;

Quiz and / or Test and / or Assignment : 15 Marks)

The pattern of TA should be declared by the concerned teacher in his / her lesson plan at the beginning of the semester and submit a copy to the Head of the Department.

To pass in the theory subject the students have to secure minimum 15 marks out of 50 marks in the End Semester Examination and total of 35 marks out of 100 marks.

End Semester Examination question papers:

08 marks × 05 questions = 40 marks 02 marks × 05 questions = 10 marks Total 50 marks

Mid Semester question papers:

08 marks × 03 questions = 24 marks 02 marks × 03 questions = 06 marks Total 30 marks

(B) Continuous Evaluation of Lab Subjects:

The total marks for sessional subject is 100. Out of which 80% of total marks to be distributed equally for each experiment and 20% of total mark for final test. Final test includes Quiz or/and Experiment or/and viva. The student has to secure 50% of total marks to pass with 'B' Grade.

2. Duration of the theory and sessional classes:

Theory Class - 1 hour Sessional Class - 2 hours

3. Class timing:

Monday - Friday 9.00 AM - 1.00 PM 1.00 PM - 2.00 PM (Lunch) 2.00 PM - 5.00 PM Saturday 9.00 AM - 1.00 PM

There will be three Classes per week for a three credit course and minimum 35 classes per semester.

(4) To run a professional elective minimum student strength should be 10 in case of UG course. For the PG courses, it will be decided by the department, which will be accommodated by regular teachers without claiming guest faculty.
